MR KITE began with a 19th-century woodtype font variously known as Jubilee and Gothic Bold. The heavy weight at the top gives it an offbeat character. My original version of that is called Blacktop, rounded out with lower-case. For this variation, I added a distressed texture that suggests a weathered sign or a well-worn T-shirt.
